### Before My Procedure:

- **NO FOOD OR DRINK** after midnight on the night before your procedure. If you have to take medications, a sip of water is okay.
- It is recommended that you **DO** try to hydrate 48 hours prior to your procedure. If you have more fluids in your system, obtaining IV access may be more comfortable.
- If you have a fever, cold, or other illness or to postpone your procedure date, please call your doctor's office as soon as possible.

### Medication Instructions: Please bring your medications with you, for clarity

- **DO NOT** take any diabetic medication, including insulin, the morning of the procedure.
- If you take any medication containing **metformin**, you'll need to stop taking it on the day of the procedure, and restart 48 hours afterwards. These include: **Glucophage, Fortamet, Janumet, Glumetza, Actoplus, Glucovance**.
- **DO NOT** take any water pills, such as **Lasix** (furosemide).
- If taking **Pradaxa, Xaralto, or Eliquis**, you must stop 3 days prior to your procedure.
- If taking **Coumadin** (warfarin), you must stop 5 days prior to the procedure.
- If allergic to **Contrast**, please take medication 48hrs (3days) prior to procedure
  - Prednisone 40mg; twice a day
  - Benadryl 50mg

Prior to your procedure, you will be asked to take care of any financial responsibilities such as copayments, deductibles, etc.
